1. Introduction

Taytly is an early-stage, experimental browser extension developed for productivity purposes. This Privacy Statement explains how information is handled. Taytly is **not currently operated by a registered legal entity**. Use of the extension is voluntary and at your own discretion and risk.

2. Information We Collect

a. User-Provided Information

When you register, log in, or interact with Taytly, we collect:

- Email address
- Full name
- Optionally, organization name or role

This is used solely for:

- Authentication
- Personalization
- Communications (e.g., critical updates)

b. Analytics and Behavioral Data

We collect anonymized usage data using Google Analytics and similar tools, including:

- Device type, OS, browser version
- IP-derived geographic region (e.g., city, country)
- Time spent on the extension
- Feature engagement and clickstreams

- Crash reports and error logs (anonymized)

We do NOT collect or store:

- AWS credentials or secrets
 - Infrastructure/project/resource metadata
 - Content created or processed by the user
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3. How We Use Your Information

Your information is used for:

- User authentication and access control
- Improving extension performance and reliability
- Monitoring for abuse and ensuring security
- Product improvement via aggregated, anonymized insights

We do NOT sell or rent your data.

4. Data Storage and Security

- Personally identifiable data (email, name) is encrypted at rest and in transit using AES-256 and TLS 1.3.
 - Access is limited using least-privilege and audit logging.
 - No unencrypted personal data is stored outside secured infrastructure.
 - Anonymous usage data is handled per Google's Privacy Policy.
 - In the event of a confirmed data breach, affected users will be notified within 72 hours, where applicable.
